Literacy – COMET programme

Attention and Listening

- Make sure your child look at you
- Play the 'go' game...give instructions and children wait for you to say 'go'
- Active listening stories..listening for particular words etc.



Phonological Awareness

- Make children aware of sounds
- Practice syllable awareness
- Say lots of rhymes...encourage them to listen for rhyme



Developing Expressive Language

- Correct their grammar...remodel if your child says the wrong pronoun etc.
- Introduce new vocabulary

Receptive Language

- Ask Who, Where, What, Why questions
- Listening skills games



Pragmatics

- Developing social skills
- Use appropriate eye contact
- Play turn taking games





- Emphasis on **sounds** - not letter names
- Each 'sound' is taught by teaching children to listen for the sound and what the sound looks like
- Each new sound has a song with actions that children learn to help them remember
- Children are taught to write the letter/s that represent that sound
- Taught to use the sounds to read and write words

Parents can help to reinforce sounds by

- encouraging your child to sing the sound song
- to think of words/ things that begin with or have that sound in them
- to write the sound correctly
- to listen for the sound in words
- to spot the sound written in print – in story books or in environmental print
- to use magnetic letters to build words that use the sounds they are learning

**5/10 minutes repetition every day will
really pay off**

High Frequency Words


- Usually 1 or 2 per week
- Sent home in homework folder (cut into flash cards and keep to use at home)

Reading Books

- Book handling skills
- Reading books will be sent home when your child is ready
- **All books must be returned each day**





Money

- Become familiar with coins





- Role play with coins
