ATTENDANCE

The Education Welfare Officer was in school during November to review attendance. She particularly reviews the attendance of children whose attendance is less than 85%. Please remember that a note must be sent to school following any period of absence.

The hall is full to capacity with children taking school dinners and therefore no additional children are able to be accommodated for occasional dinners. <u>Only those children who have been taking dinners on a regular basis will be able to have dinners during December.</u>

Thank you to all those who supported our Winter Market. There was a great selection of stalls selling a wide variety of items. Thanks are expressed to all the parents and staff who made preparations for the event and assisted on the evening. Many people commented on the welcoming atmosphere within the school and it was great that members of the local community joined with us. A total of £474 was raised on the evening.

CAR PARKING

Please remember to exercise care both when driving near the school and when parking. A parked car belonging to a parent was hit by another parent's car in Wilgar Street recently and it was disappointing and very annoying that the driver did not stop. Cars continue to park on the yellow lines at the main entrance which is a safety issue for those walking near the gates. Please also remember that only cars belonging to members of staff are permitted in the car park.

P1 & P2 CHRISTMAS CONCERT/P3 CHRISTMAS NATIVITY

In previous years it was disappointing that a number of parents, who did not purchase tickets on time, were abusive to office staff. The number of seats in the school hall is limited due to fire & health and safety regulations. Tickets are therefore limited to 2 per family for the P1 & P2 concert and 4 per family for the P3 Nativity. Tickets will sell quickly. It is important that you follow the instructions for ordering tickets and return the reply slip and money to the class teacher. Tickets will not be sold directly from the office. It is hoped that all parents will co-operate with these arrangements.

CHRISTMAS PRESENTS

As mentioned in the previous newsletter school staff would be very happy if parents once again, instead of buying presents for members of staff, gave a donation to the Cancer Fund for Children Appeal. Envelopes will be sent home during December.

CHRISTMAS FUN MORNING

Arrangements are in hand for the Christmas Fun Morning, which will be held on Friday 21 December. It will be a Christmas Jumper Day and <u>break</u> will be provided for all children. **School will finish at 12.15pm and <u>there will be no dinners or packed lunches</u>. NURSERY AND PRIMARY 1 ADMISSIONS FOR SEPTEMBER 2019

The Education Authority has changed the process for applications to Nursery and Primary 1 for September 2019 intake. The information we have to date is as follows:

- Applications for both Nursery and Primary 1 will be through an online portal
- Information about the criteria of all schools, nursery units and playgroups will be available on the Education Authority website from Friday 14 December 2018
- The online portal will be available from **10.00am on Wednesday 2 January until midnight on Thursday 31 January 2019** for punctual applications. Any applications submitted after this date will be treated as late applications.
- As in previous years parents will nominate schools/settings in order of preference
- Parents will be required to provide to their first preference school/setting an original birth certificates, 2 proofs of home address and, if applicable for Nursery, evidence of entitlement for the social disadvantage criterion. This documentation should be submitted as soon as possible after completing the application and not later than 4.00pm on Friday 8 February 2019. Failure to supply evidence by this date may result in a place not being offered
- Only information that has been provided on the online application and any documents submitted to the school will be used to determine the allocation of places

The Education Authority Admissions Office is providing further information and training for Principals and school administration staff at the end of November. I will provide parents with updated information as soon as it is available.

We will be holding a Nursery and Primary 1 Open Afternoon/Evening on Tuesday 15 January 2019 from 3.00-4.00pm and 6.30-7.30pm. If you have friends/neighbours who will be applying for Nursery or Primary 1 places, please share this information with them.

PRIMARY 3 TRANSFER TO STRANDTOWN

Application forms for current P3s will be available from the start of January and will be sent home when we receive them from Strandtown. Completed applications should be returned to <u>STRANDTOWN</u> <u>PRIMARY by THURSDAY 31 JANUARY AT 4pm</u>. Mrs Hutchinson will be providing further information in due course.

CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS

Please remember that School will finish for all children on **Friday 21 December at 12.15pm**. <u>There will be no</u> <u>dinners or packed lunches</u>. School will recommence on Friday 4 January 2019.
